Well Pet Clinic Project Update!

Introducing the HSWC Well-Pet Center, still under construction but scheduled to become fully operational during April 2024! This project has been 10 years in the planning; culminating in a 1000+ square foot building on our property, the first of its kind in Waupaca County. There we will perform spays/neuters, vaccinations, microchipping and routine blood tests.

Continuing and building upon our existing spay/neuter program, we will still serve the public in Waupaca, Waushara and Shawano counties as well as rescues and shelters from all over Wisconsin. Monthly vaccination/microchip clinics are planned starting later in April 2024.

This project was made possible through the generosity of donors! Our final payment to the builder will be coming due in April, 2024 and we are fervently hoping we will not need to rely on a mortgage to make that payment. While we are eternally grateful for all the donations thus far, we are compelled to ask again. Avoiding the monthly mortgage payment is key in keeping our fees as affordable as they can be!



Please help!! As of this writing, we still need to raise over \$175,000 to complete this project and finish furnishing the building. Heart Ache and Happiness...

Tommy Pickles and his brother Dil Pickles came to HSWC as happy healthy kittens during March of 2023. In August we noticed Tommy was coughing and his breathing was labored. After monitoring him for a couple hours, xrays were ordered to see what was going on. It's a good thing we did because we discovered Tommy had pulmonary edema, meaning he had fluid around his lungs. Dr. Ziegler had us start him on Lasix and we continued to closely monitor him.

Dr. Ziegler diagnosed Tommy with a significant heart murmur that wasn't present during his neuter surgery 5 months prior. After a lot of research and networking we were connected with a cat cardiologist at UW Veterinary Medicine in Madison who was interested in doing an



exam and tests on Tommy so we could hopefully get answers on his heart condition.

Early in December, Monica P took Tommy to his appointment with the cardiologist. The news was devastating... Tommy was diagnosed with significant, inoperable heart disease and there was nothing we could do besides continue his meds and keep him as comfortable as possible.



Over the next month Tommy was doing well on his medication and enjoyed getting all the extra love from staff and volunteers. Unfortunately, shortly into the new year, we noticed Tommy's health was starting to decline and he no longer had an appetite. Monday, January 8, surrounded by so much love, Tommy gently crossed over the Rainbow Bridge.

Tommy's cardiologist asked if we'd be willing to donate his body so they could learn more about his condition and help other cats in the future. Of course, we agreed because it was

Tommy's legacy of love, that he could provide a learning opportunity and possibly spare another cat's life.

Oh Tommy, we will always remember your sweet snuggles and thunder purr!

We experience heart ache.... And we also experience happiness...

Our Beloved Tommy and our Sweet Granny

Around the time of Tommy's diagnosis we took in a stray senior cat we called "Granny" who was a sweet old lady kitty. She seemed to be in good health until a few days after her spay procedure when it became clear she was struggling. She became lethargic and refused food.

During a day of sub Q fluids, syringe feedings and heating pads, we checked her blood sugar and it was more than six times higher than normal. Granny had gone into ketoacidosis and we had to act quickly to start her on insulin to control her blood sugar plus IV fluids to help restore her hydration and flush out her system. Within 24 hours, Granny showed huge improvement and started moving around and eating on her own!



We're happy to say that after being on regular insulin and diabetic cat food she's doing wonderful! We've been able to stop her insulin injections and she's gained over 3 pounds! She is "special needs" because of the diabetes, but she is ready for adoption.

These cats are vastly different and had very different outcomes. Both of their stories are a testament to how much time, effort and expense we invest in the wellness of our resident animals, and how engaged our medical team and animal care staff are.

All of us at HSWC wish to express our appreciation to the following for helping with these cases: UW Madison Veterinary Medicine; James Ziegler, DVM; Diane Scott; DVM, Leah Nehila, DVM; Portage County Humane Society; Pete Gasper, DVM; Orphan Animal Rescue, and the unknown person who donated the Insulin that ended up saving Granny's life.





once she's befriended her human she's very sweet and loving. She's been best pals with Helen and Jonesy for a long time. She'd probably love to go home with one or both of then.




Sonic






